How to Support Students with Dyslexia

Do you know how to support your dyslexic students fully?

Are you identifying students with dyslexia early in their studies?

Do your dyslexic students get more than assistive technology as part of their D.S.A?

80% of students in receipt of Disabled Students Allowance (D.S.A.) have dyslexia related issues, yet it is one of the least understood conditions. We have two courses designed specifically for those supporting or teaching students (over 16 years old) with dyslexia. Further courses are available and each full day provides specific strategies focusing on reading, spelling, writing and dyscalculia respectively. **All dates refer to courses in 2012.**

1. Practical Solutions for Dyslexia (1 day) £180 per person

2. Screening for Dyslexia (1 day) £200 per person

London 09 Mar Birmingham 27 Apr Manchester 25 May London 17 Jul

Training days are 9:45 to 4:30. We can also run these courses at your own venue for groups.

We have further courses available as follows. Although these are not specifically tailored to HE/FE, they will give significant insights into helping those with dyslexia and related conditions to learn. They also demonstrate relevant teaching skills to those with lower abilities.

3. Practical Solutions Plus (1 day each on reading, spelling and writing) £125 pp per day

Each day of this 3 day course takes a different theme . one day on a variety of reading schemes, one devoted to spelling and another on different writing strategies and study skills.

4. Managing Dyscalculia Inclusively (1 day) 9:45 – 3:30 £125 pp*

This one day course aims to develop an understanding of how dyscalculia and other SpLDs can adversely affect students in mathematical aspects of their studies. It offers many practical ways of teaching maths inclusively to students of various abilities and all ages.

Level 2 and 3 Accredited Courses in Dyslexia Screening and Support £762 / £971 pp

These accredited programmes will enable you to gain a good understanding of the dyslexia spectrum. The training days are all 9:45 to 4:30.

Accredited Level 2 Programme

The Level 2 programme consists of 3 days of face to face training (Day 1 Practical Solutions for Dyslexia, Day 2 Screening for Dyslexia, Day 3 Practical Solutions Plus . choose a full day on either Reading, Writing or Spelling) an open learning workbook and a reflective assignment. Course fees are **£762** per person. This includes the registration fee of £12.

This programme is also available in-house where the cost would be £3,300 (plus registration fees per person) for a group booking for up to 20 delegates.

Accredited Level 3 Programme

The Level 3 version has 5 days of training (the Level 2 training days above, plus the other two days of Practical Solutions Plus). There is also a relevant assignment. This programme will enable you to design dyslexia friendly literacy support for effective learning by dyslexic individuals and those who are less able. Course fees are **£971** per person. This includes the registration fee of £21.
