Travel to the conference by rail:

to Reading Station (connections to London, Basingstoke, Birmingham, Bournemouth, Bristol, Cheltenham, Great Malvern, Manchester, Newcastle, Oxford, Penzance, Redhill, Worcester) and then by taxi to Institute of Education. Make sure you ask the taxi driver to take you to **Bulmershe, Woodlands Avenue (NOT the main Whiteknights campus)**

Travel to the conference by car:

The easiest and most direct route is via the M4 motorway.

Leave the motorway at Junction 11

When you reach the roundabout at the top of the slip road take the B3270 (signposted to Earley & University).

Follow this road around to the right and at the first roundabout turn left on to the A327 (Shinfield Road).

Follow this road and go straight across two mini roundabouts.

At the next traffic light junction, turn right onto Pepper Lane.

Turn left at the roundabout at the end of Pepper Lane.

Continue along this road, straight across three mini roundabouts and one traffic light junction.

At the next mini roundabout turn right onto Woodlands Avenue.

You will see the Bulmershe Court campus on your right hand side.

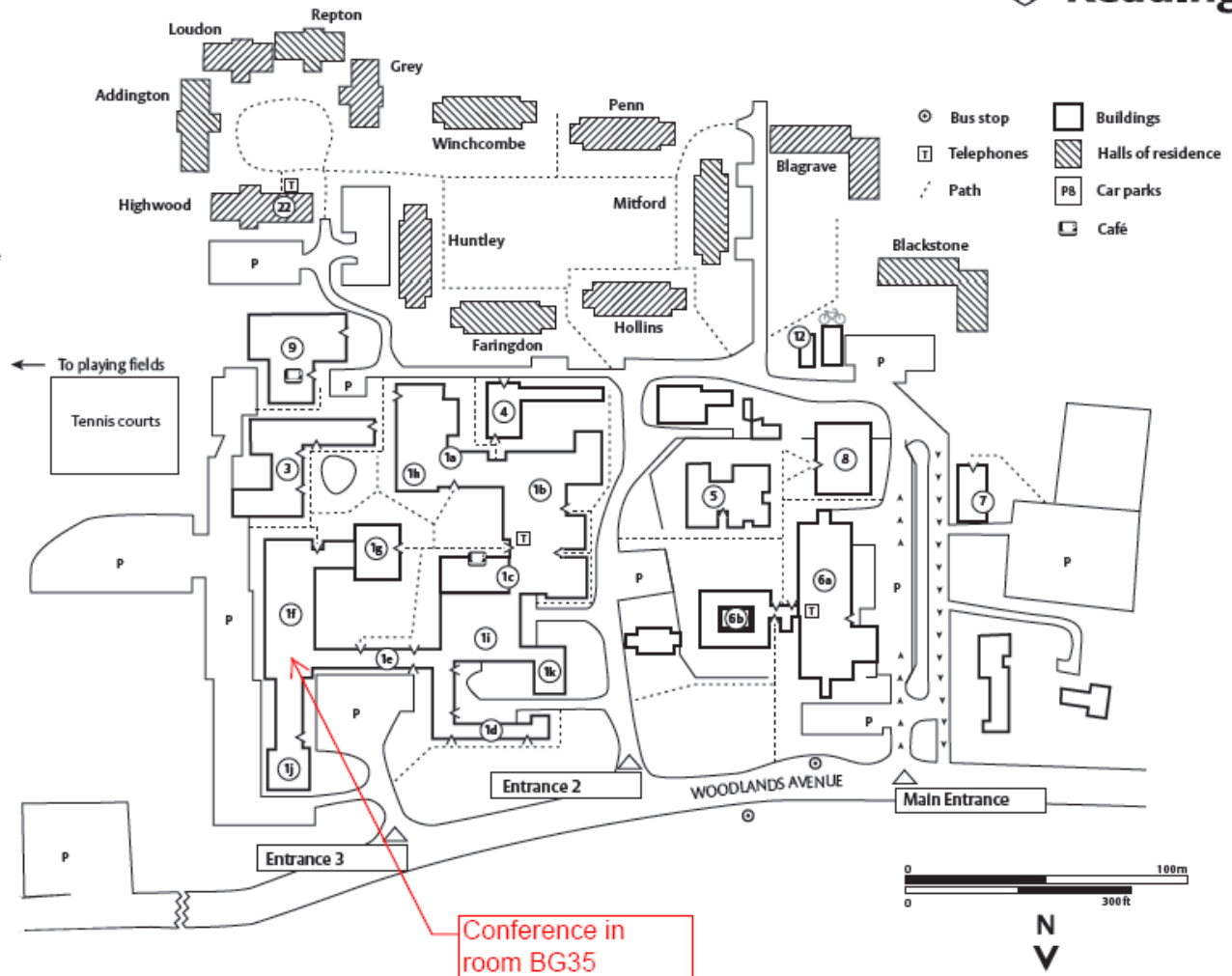
